Criminal cases now online

The Supreme Court has added more valuable information to the expanding database on its website. The Court's Criminal Case Inventory, which provides details on current criminal matters before the Supreme Court, is now freely available via the Internet.

The list is found on the Supreme Court website at www.supremecourt.wa.gov.au Go to 'Listings and Decisions' then 'Criminal Cases'.

The inventory, which is regularly updated, provides the name of each accused, the charge, previous and upcoming hearing dates and the plea by the accused.

The online list will assist interested parties to track matters as they progress through the system. The inventory does not include cases being heard in the Magistrates Court Stirling Gardens.

The Supreme Court's email subscription service has been expanded to include the inventory so that automatic updates will be emailed to subscribers.

To keep up-to-date, people can subscribe to one or more of these choices, via the website. A link to the subscribed material will be automatically emailed to a nominated email account or sent via a RSS feed.
