



SUPREME COURT OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA

PUBLIC NOTICE - COVID-19

This notice applies to the Supreme Court of Western Australia's premises at the David Malcolm Justice Centre and Stirling Gardens in Perth.

In accordance with the announcement by the State government as to changes to public health measures, from 10 June 2022 the *Court and Tribunal Worker (Restrictions on Access) Directions (Directions)* will no longer be in force. Accordingly, the direction made under the *Directions* requiring the production of evidence of a person's vaccination status to enter the Court buildings will also cease.

The repeal of the *Directions* does not in any way limit the power of individual judicial officers conducting hearings or mediations to impose such measures as are appropriate in the circumstances, including the wearing of masks or other precautions.
