Interactive Online Probate Forms on Website

A new interactive online system located on the Supreme Court of Western Australia website makes applying for probate easier.

Interactive online probate forms are now available [through the website](#). The new system helps people with the preparation of the forms needed to apply for a Non-contentious Grant of Probate. These forms include the motion paper, affidavit and statement of assets and liabilities.

The [online system](#) greatly improves access to the forms required to make an application for a Grant of Probate, as previously forms were only available through the Citizens Advice Bureau.

The system guides the applicant through the completion of the forms, ensuring the forms are completed with greater accuracy.

The applicant then prints the forms and lodges them in person at the Probate Office at Level 14, 111 St George's Terrace, Perth, along with the original will and death certificate. Only the executor, or lawyer representing the executor, can apply.

Due to the complexity of some applications, this system can only be used to prepare applications for simple Grants of Probate. This does not include applications for Letters of Administration.
