## OPEN DAY 2009

Government House & the Supreme Court of Western Australia are jointly hosting an Open Day on Sunday, 18 October 2009 from 11am – 4pm.

The Governor of Western Australia and the Chief Justice of Western Australia invite members of the public to explore and experience part of the cultural heritage of Western Australia.

Members of the public will be able to visit the historic Supreme Court, including the cells beneath the building, and hear talks by Judges of the Court. Visitors will be able to tour courtrooms and view judges' chambers inside the heritage-listed building on a [self-guided tour](#).

Displays throughout the building will outline the [history](#) of the Supreme Court.

The adjacent Old Court House Law Museum, the oldest building in Perth, will also be open to the public. Constructed in 1836, it was the most prominent building in the early days of the Swan River Colony.

People are also invited to tour the public rooms of Government House, the ballroom & the gardens, picnic on the lawns and enjoy the entertainment provided throughout the day.

Refreshments will be on sale in the Government House Ballroom Supper Room.

Wheelchair access for disabled persons is available.
