State of Western Australia v Edwards – Information for the Public

The Supreme Court trial of Bradley Robert Edwards will resume on Monday, 23 March 2020.

In response to the impact of COVID-19, the availability of seating for the public will be reduced to allow more space between individuals.

As members of the public are encouraged not to attend, an edited audio recording of the proceedings will be uploaded to the Supreme Court website as soon as practical.

This audio recording is not to be copied.

Where necessary, trial witnesses will be able to give evidence by video.

The Court has made arrangements for additional cleaning of the courtroom and public access points.

The trial will generally commence at 10.00 am each day.

Lunch adjournments will be between 1.00 pm and 2.15 pm. The proceedings will generally finish for the day by 4.30 pm.

Recording, sketching and note taking is not permitted (other than by permission of the trial judge, which is generally limited to the media).
