NOTICE TO PRACTITIONERS

Changes to the filing of appeal books in the Court of Appeal pending the establishment of elodgement and efilng

Effective immediately, the following changes will apply to the filing of appeal books in the Court of Appeal, pending the establishment of elodgement and efilng, where the appellant is represented by a legal practitioner unless otherwise directed by a Registrar upon application in a particular case:

- The appellant must file at the Court of Appeal Office one hard copy of the white, blue and green appeal books in relation to both civil and criminal appeals. There will be no requirement for the appellant to provide an additional three hard copies of the appeal books.
- A copy of the appeal books must be made available to the Court by the appellant sharing a link by email to a Dropbox account or to a OneDrive folder which contains the appeal books.
- The appellant must still comply with the *Supreme Court (Court of Appeal) Rules 2005* in regard to service of the appeal books.

The standard Registrars' orders regarding the filing and serving of appeal books will be amended to give effect to the above changes.
